PLANNING COMMISSION MINUTES CITY OF FORT ATKINSON APRIL 10, 2018 990TH MEETING

CALL TO ORDER.

The meeting was called to order by Chairman Trebatoski in the Council Chambers of the Municipal Building at 4:00 pm.

ROLL CALL.

Present: Commissioners Greenhalgh, Lescohier, City Manager Trebatoski and City Engineer Andy Selle. Also present: City Attorney, City Clerk/Treasurer and Building Inspector.

Absent: Commissioner Frame, Scherer and Highfield.

APPROVE MINUTES OF MARCH 13, 2018 PLANNING COMMISSION MEETING.

Cm. Greenhalgh motioned, seconded by Cm. Lescohier to approve the minutes of the March 13, 2018 Planning Commission meeting. Motion carried.

REVIEW AND APPROVE REQUEST FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT FOR AUTO SALES AND SERVICE AT 815 JEFFERSON (CURRENTLY ZONED M-2) (PREVIOUSLY APPROVED FOR THIS SAME TYPE OF BUSINESS, HOWEVER, THERE IS A PROPRIETOR CHANGE). Engineer Selle introduced the request that entails a new tenant for 815 Jefferson Street. The business will consist of used vehicle sales and repairs. All departments have reviewed the request with the following comments:

Zoning: the property is zoned M-2 with all requirements being met. A handicap access must be provided pursuant to 15.10.1 (H) of the Zoning Code. Once the facility reaches 10 vehicles on the site at any one time – all areas used for parking and work areas must be paved in accordance with 15.1031 (G) of the Zoning Code. Landscaping – the mature trees along the north portion of the lot should remain. Paving for the parking area may need to be adjusted slightly to accommodate this. Leaving this space will meet the requirements of section 15.10.2 (L) of the Zoning Code.

<u>Stormwater</u>: the additional pavement should be graded to drain to the north edge of the property along the grass/tree line so infiltration can occur and mitigate the additional impervious surface of the lot. An outline of the proposed paved areas and the grades of said areas shall be submitted to the City Engineer for review prior to commencing work.

Cm. Greenhalgh moved to approve the conditional use permit for auto sales and service at 815 Jefferson Street, currently zoned M-2 with the conditions provided regarded the zoning, stormwater and requirement of handicap parking be developed if the 10 vehicle limit is reached. Motion seconded by Engineer Selle and carried.

ADJOURNMENT

Cm. Greenhalgh moved, Cm. Lescohier seconded the motion to adjourn the Planning Commission meeting at 4:05 pm. Motion carried.







SUBJECT: Mobile Merchant Application – TNT Fireworks

Background:

TO:

Ordinance #723 regulating mobile merchants was adopted on October 21, 2014. Approval of a mobile merchant permit is required by the Planning Commission upon a satisfactory investigation of the applicant's business and moral character.

Mobile merchants may operate on private property in the following zoned districts: C-1, C-2, C-3, C-5, M-1 and M-2. If the renting or leasing property, a valid lease must be provided.

Discussion:

Matthew Sokol of TNT Fireworks applied for such permit to operate a stand at Pick N' Save to sell products as authorized by State Statute 167.10. A letter was provided by the owner of the property confirming the allowance for the business.

167.10 Regulation of fireworks.

- (1) DEFINITION. In this section, "fireworks" means anything manufactured, processed or packaged for exploding, emitting sparks or combustion which does not have another common use, but does not include any of the following:
- (e) A cap containing not more than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture, if the cap is used or possessed or sold for use in a device which prevents direct bodily contact with a cap when it is in place for explosion.
 - (f) A toy snake which contains no mercury.
- (i) A sparkler on a wire or wood stick not exceeding 36 inches in length that is designed to produce audible or visible effects or to produce audible and visible effects.
- (j) A device designed to spray out paper confetti or streamers and which contains less than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture.
- (k) A fuseless device that is designed to produce audible or visible effects or audible and visible effects, and that contains less than one-quarter grain of explosive mixture.
- (L) A device that is designed primarily to burn pyrotechnic smoke-producing mixtures, at a controlled rate, and that produces audible or visible effects, or audible and visible effects.
- (m) A cylindrical fountain that consists of one or more tubes and that is classified by the federal department of transportation as a Division 1.4 explosive, as defined in 49 CFR 173.50.
- (n) A cone fountain that is classified by the federal department of transportation as a Division 1.4 explosive, as defined in 49 CFR 173.50.
 - (p) A novelty device that spins or moves on the ground.

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The request was provided to Departments for review with the following comments.

Fire Department: Division Chief Gerondale stated the same restrictions apply as last year. *TNT could still sell items like sparklers, fountain cones, snakes, etc. Please ensure all parties involved clearly understand that the Mobile Merchant Permit is only an approval for the sale of general merchandise and is not construed as a permit to possess, sell, or use "Fireworks" as defined in 167.10.*

Police Department: We have had no negative issues resulting in this business or the business rep listed on the request. In-house check reveals no calls for service reference the business over the past few years.

The Police Department has no concerns reference the permit. The sale, stocking or storing of an illegal fireworks on the premise or their storage container left at the lot will not be tolerated however. Unannounced inspections may be administered to ensure compliance.

Financial Analysis:

The applicant provided the \$25.00 application fee and the six month license fee of \$25.00.

Staff Recommendation:

Staff recommends approval of the mobile merchant license for Mathew Sokol of TNT Fireworks for the sale of firework products allowed by State Statute 167.10 and the sale of products not listed as allowable would cause immediate license revocation and business closure.

LICENSE AGREEMENT

This License Agreement is made by and between Roundy's Supermarkets, Inc. a Wisconsin Corporation (herein after referred to as "Licensor") and American Promotional Events, Inc. – East, an Alabama Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Licensee").

In consideration of the mutual agreements herein contained, and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and sufficiency of which is hereby acknowledged, the parties hereto hereby agree as follows:

- 1. GRANT OF LICENSE: Subject to the terms and conditions hereof, Licensor hereby grants to Licensee an exclusive license to erect a sales tent for the selling of State-legal 1.4G (Class C) consumer fireworks and novelty items (the "License") on mutually agreed upon portions of the 4 parking lots on each of the Licensor's premises as set forth on Exhibit A attached hereto (collectively, the "Premises"). The License shall allow Licensee, its employees and agents to enter upon the Premises in order to erect and maintain a sales tent (which shall be a temporary structure and is hereinafter individually referred to as a "Tent") and to place other personal property on the Premises for the purpose described in Section 3 below.
- 2. TERM OF LICENSE: The License shall commence on June 17, 2018 and expire at the close of business on July 8, 2018. Retail sales at the Tent located on the Premises will occur from approximately June 20, 2018 through and including July 5, 2018. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary set forth herein, Licensor may terminate the License if (a) the actions of Licensee or the terms of this License Agreement conflict with the Licensor's Prime Lease relating to the premises or any amendments thereto (the "Prime Lease"), or (b) the Landlord (as hereinafter defined) fails to provide or revokes any required consent regarding the grant of the License, or (c) Licensee breaches any provision of this Agreement and falls to cure such breach to the reasonable satisfaction of Licensor after within one (1) day following receipt of written notice from Licensor of such breach, except in the case of a breach of Section 4, in which case, Licensor may terminate the License immediately. Licensor and Licensee each acknowledge that this License shall be subordinate to Licensor's Prime Lease in all respects.
- 3. PRIME LEASE: Agreement between Owner of the Property (Landlord) and Licensor (Tenant).
- 4. LICENSEE'S ACTIVITES: The business conducted within the Tent shall consist of State-legal 1.4G (Class C) consumer fireworks and other novelty items offered to the public for sale. All activities conducted by Licensee on the Premises shall meet all Local, State and Federal laws. The Licensee shall obtain all necessary permits, Licenses, approvals, and any other government authorization needed to operate its business lawfully upon the Premises.
- CANCELLATION: In the event that Licensee is unable to secure the necessary Licenses
 and/or permits from governing authorities to open for business, or reasonable access to water or
 electricity then this License Agreement shall with regard to that particular premises, become null
 and void.

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- 6. TENT OPERATION: Licensee shall conduct its activities within the Tent at all times in a safe and orderly manner. Licensee shall provide, at Licensees expense, all personnel, equipment, and other items necessary to set-up, operate, and take down the Tent including, but not limited to:
 - a. Cleaning of Premises and area immediately surrounding Premises. Licensee shall haul away its trash at its own expense.
 - b. Tent promotion, advertising and security.
- 7. FEE:

- 8. UTILITIES: Licensor shall allow Licensee to hook up to water and electricity for Licensee's use during the entire term of this lease. Utilities are to be available 24-hours per day. The Licensee shall be responsible for and promptly pay all charges for such electricity and water used during the term of this License.
- 9. INSURANCE

10. FINAL CLEAN-UP: Licensee shall be responsible for final clean-up of site after completion of License. Licensee will remove all equipment, structures, product, etc. and return

parking lot to its condition prior to the commencement of this License, including filling any and all penetrations, ordinary wear and tear accepted. Should Licensor have to self perform for items not cleaned up or restored to the condition prior to the execution of this License Agreement Licensee agrees to then reimburse Licensor for such items prior to August 1, 2018. Licensor will provide sufficient detail to Licensee of any such reimbursable items.

- SAVINGS CLAUSE: The invalidity or unenforceability of any provision of this License Agreement shall not affect or impair the validity of any other provision.
- 12. CARE OF PREMISES: Licensee has the obligation to restore any damaged areas to the common area resulting from Licensee's use of the Premises. Licensee shall keep all exterior storefront surfaces of the Premises clean and maintain the Premises at its expense in a clean, orderly and sanitary condition.
- 13. M. INDEMNITY AND WAIVER OF SUBROGATION:
